The winner will receive either a \$200.00 reward or a gift card from Barnes & Noble and have the award presented at the annual YSS Spring Conference.

Entries must be received by **December 6, 2024 before midnight** for programs produced between December 1, 2023 and November 30, 2024.



### Pied Piper Award 2025

#### **Guidelines for Submission**

- 1. All submissions must have been created and implemented in a New York State library within the twelve months prior to December 1st of the award year, i.e. between December 1, 2023 and November 30, 2024.
- 2. The applicant must be a current member of NYLA/YSS and working in a public library, school library, or library system in New York State. If a submission has multiple applicants, at least one applicant must be a NYLA/YSS member.
- 3. All materials submitted must be free of all copyright restrictions. The copyright statement on the application form must be signed.
- 4. Submissions should include answers to these questions:
  - a. A summary of the program and steps one could take to replicate it
  - b. Why the program addresses a need in the community
  - c. Why the program is original and creative
  - d. How your program effectively filled a need, or how you knew it was successful.
- 5. Submit three (3) full color sets and one (1) black and white master set of all program materials if submission is mailed, or one (1) color copy if emailed.

#### \*Please note:

- The winner will be announced at the 2025 YSS Spring Conference.
- The Director of the winning library will receive a letter to inform them of the award.
- YSS Executive Board members and Pied Piper Committee members may not apply for the Pied Piper Award during their term of office.
- By submitting an entry, all responsible parties agree that other librarians may use, reproduce, and/or adapt the work to their own needs, provided proper credit is given. The basic concept of the printed material or program must be relatively easy to reproduce.
- Those responsible for submission of the winning submission may be asked to do one of the following:
  - Create a presentation board to be displayed during the YSS Spring Conference.
  - Supply copies of their publication or program information for distribution to YSS members at the Spring Conference.
  - Present their program at the roundtable during NYLA Conference or the following year's YSS Spring Conference.
  - Submit the information electronically so that it may be reproduced in our YSS Newsletter or on the YSS website.
